





- Click download which will get a version for your system (e.g., Protégé.app for a Mac)
- You'll have an option of also getting a platform-independent version that will require the Java Runtime Environment

Protégé out of the box


- Standard features include
 - W3C standards compliant
 - Customizable user interface
 - Visualization support
 - Ontology refactoring support
 - Direct interface to reasoners
 - Highly pluggable architecture
 - Cross compatible with WebProtégé
- There are other plug-ins that you can install
